

**NOTICE OF LANDOWNERS' MEETING AND BOARD OF

TO: ALL OWNERS OF LAND WITHIN SEMINOLE IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Landowners' Meeting of the Seminole Improvement District ("District"), previously scheduled for Monday, June 1, 2026, has been rescheduled to Monday, June 15, 2026, at 3:30 p.m. at the Westlake Offices, located at 4001 Seminole Pratt Whitney Road, Westlake, Florida. A regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors will commence at 4:00 p.m. to address organizational matters.

This meeting is being held pursuant to Chapter 2000-431, Laws of Florida, for the purpose of electing one Supervisor for the District. Seat #1 will serve a three-year term expiring June, 2029. At such meeting, each landowner shall be entitled to cast one vote per acre of land owned by him or her and located within the District for the Seat to be elected. A fraction of an acre shall be treated as one acre. A landowner may vote in person or via proxy. The meetings are open to the public and will be conducted in accordance with the provisions of Florida law. The meetings may be continued to a date, time and location to be specified on the record at the meetings.
